

AMA announced that the FCC has acted on the new frequency allocations. We now have 10 new channels available for RC flying, and additional channels for cars, boats and robots. Our existing channels may be used without modification until January 1988. At that point we must be switched to the new narrow band equipment. In many cases this will require work on older equipment by the manufacturer.

If you purchase new equipment on the new channels I think it would be prudent to check your radio with others on the flying site prior to flying. Check it for cross talk between sets. Some of the older equipment may be so poorly tuned as to be sensitive to adjacent channels. It's better to check than to fly and lose.
