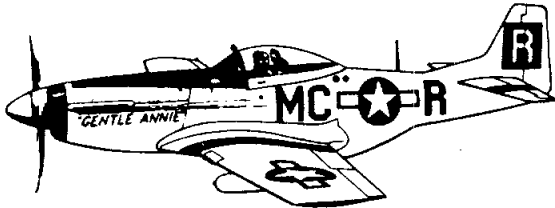

FAI F3B is scheduled for 18 April (Sunday). This should prove to be a very interesting meet. Again, help will be need to support the event - please call Jim Farris.

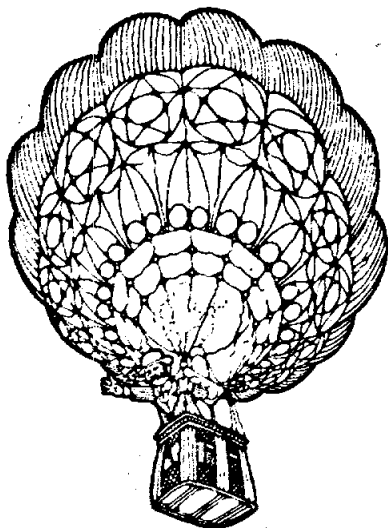
## MODEL OF THE MONTH:
