The Safety Committee has met and a final flying site layout has been prepared. All of the known concerns voiced by members, recommendations presented by AMA publications, telephone conversations with AMA headquarters, and existing physical conditions (wind direction, sun location, existing structures, etc.) were just some of the influencing factors considered in determining the new layout. Because of the time limitations and delays caused by "me", the revised MSC/RCC Field Diagram, Safety Rules and Procedures have not been included in this newsletter. Packets will be made up and will be available at the March meeting. Be sure to pick up one and become familiar with the layout and the revised rules and procedures. Weather permitting, a paint party will be held on **Saturday March 12th, 1988** starting at 8 AM. **There will be no flying that day**, so you might as well show up with a shovel, broom, gas weedeater and/or a wheel barrow to help out. Keeping in line with the forthcoming 1991 rules, the current Safety Committee has deemed it necessary to announce that as of January 1st 1991 all radios used at the MSC/RCC flying site will have to be FM. **No AM radios will be allowed.**
