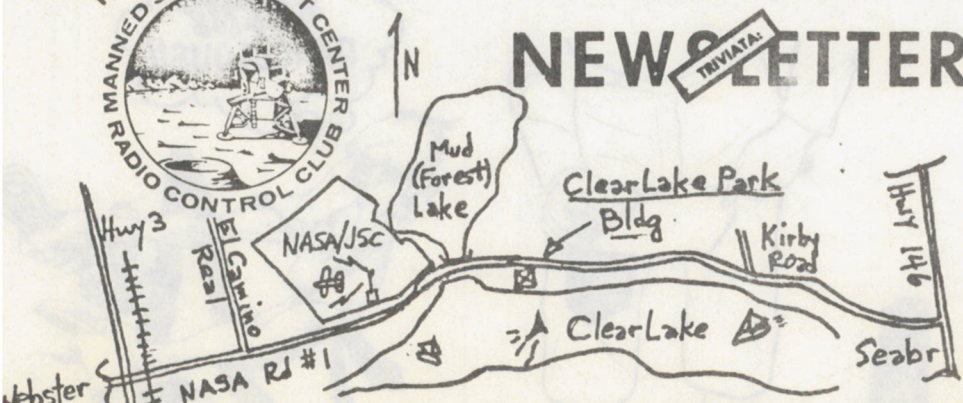

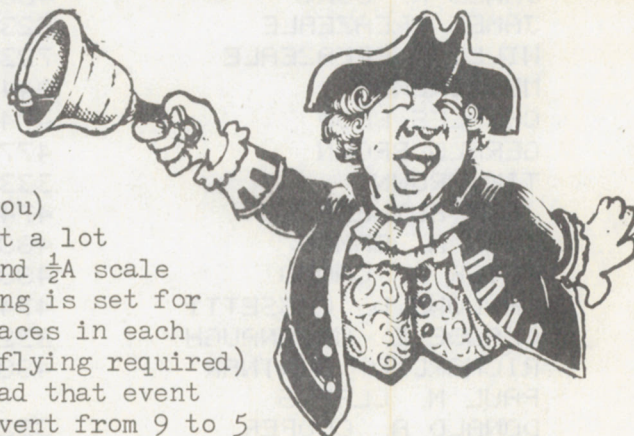
Are You One Of The 100,000?

REGIONAL SCALE AND RADIO CONTROLLED OLD TIMER CONTEST!!!

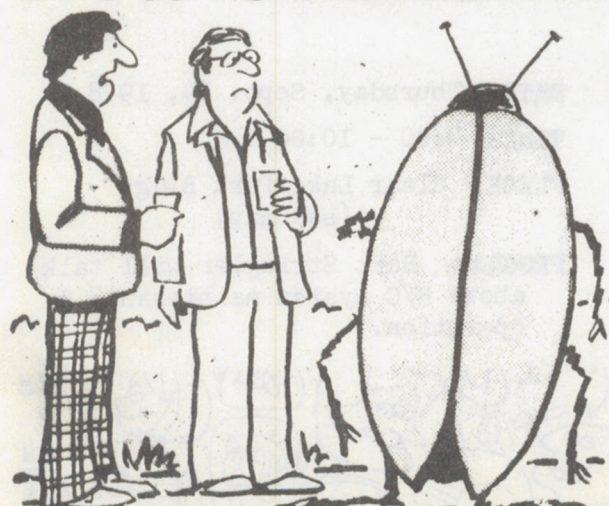
If you don't know about this, you should. We (including you) are holding this bash on Sept. 16-17, and it should attract a lot of attention. On Saturday there will be Stand-Off Scale and $\frac{1}{2}$ A scale beginning at 8 AM. Static judging begins at 8:30 and flying is set for 10:00 on through the afternoon. Trophies for the top 3 places in each event will be awarded plus a high static score trophy (no flying required) in Stand-Off. The $\frac{1}{2}$ A scale should be fun: we have never had that event before!! Then, on Sunday, there will be a Mammoth Scale event from 9 to 5 and an R/C Old Timer from 8 to about 1 PM. Trophies will be given in Mammoth for Best Overall Achievement, Best Finish, and Most Unusual -- awards to be determined by the contestants' votes. Trophies for top 3 in Old Timer. As usual, Owen Morris - Man About Town, Bon Vivant, & Kool Kat - will serve as the Contest Director. Help will be needed, so plan to attend the Sept. meeting where the final details will be discussed, coordinated, argued, forgotten, etc.!!!



Did you think that we had forgotten about John & Pete Campo's monthly Saturday Specials? Not at all!! To catch everyone up, the Donut Drop event was held in June - and it was a ball! There were 8 entries with 5 having release mechanisms on the airplane. The others just strapped-on a peg to carry the "bomb". Naturally, having a release made for better accuracy: the closest to the target was 2'6".
