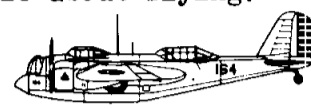

Here is something else we have ~~stolen~~ chosen to reprint (parts of) from the excellent MARCS SPARKS newsletter from Madison, Wisc. "When I saw the ad for the new Hobby Lobby radio, my curiosity was aroused. It sure looked like a ProLine....The radio arrived in a very well packaged box and foam container. The inside box flap did indeed have the ProLine return address label on it....It is a no frills basic 4 chan. (6 chan. for \$20 more) of American manufacture. The quality was exceptional and the design uncompromised. This is truly one of the best bargains I have ever seen. Performance was flawless....The TX features nice open gimbal sticks and the unsurpassed ProLine RF deck. The TX encoder uses the 5044 IC. This same IC, used in a different configuration, is the heart of the Ace Silver Seven, Airtronics, and WE new breed of "gadget" TX's... Neutral pulse width is 1.5 ms ± 0.5 for control. This is the most common and accepted pulse standard, so it will be compatible with most popular servos and after-market flite packs....FX has built in Deans connector block and separate ail. pigtail. RF-IF section is of traditional design with double-tuned front end, RF amp, 3 tunable IF transformers...decoder features the 5045 IC with a built in voltage regulator. Decoder outputs to servos are positive pulse so you can use other popular servos. No corners cut in RX design, quality, & construction. Nothing about this set is shortchanged...."
