If you are not on the list--you will not be able to fly in January until the list is updated with NASA Security--which can take from one to four weeks after you renew.

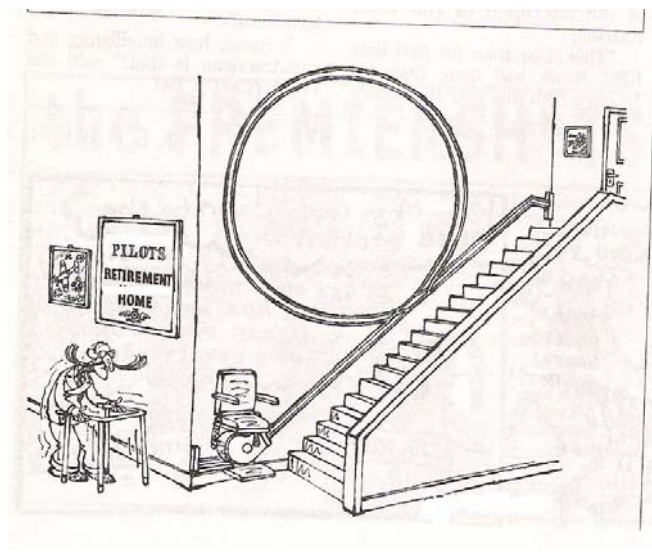
